

Evaluation report

As Lithuanian national team of 4 peoples we participated in the Erasmus+ project *Sustainable Business Matters: From Scratch to Pitch* in Cyprus during the period of May 16th to 25th 2025. Our participation in the project was an enriching, inspiring, and transformative experience for all of us. Representing Tėkmė School, we had the opportunity to learn, grow, and connect in a truly international setting that combined creativity, entrepreneurship, and sustainability.

Throughout the week, we were engaged in a wide range of activities—from theoretical discussions and practical workshops to practical challenges and team-building exercises. These sessions not only deepened our understanding of sustainability and the SDGs but also encouraged us to think critically, find new ways of collaboration, and explore our personal and professional limits. The creative tasks, such as pitching unusual products or visualizing our futures, pushed us outside our comfort zones in the most empowering ways.
